NOTICE OF MAILED BALLOT ELECTION

PURPOSE OF THIS ELECTION: This election is to determine the representative, if any, desired by the eligible employees for the purpose of meeting and conferring with their employer.

VOTER ELIGIBILITY: The employees eligible to vote in this election are those employees in the Unit 7 Protective Services & Public Safety unit of the State of California who were employed on the cutoff date for voter eligibility, September 2, 2005, and who are still employed on the date they cast their ballot.

YOUR NAME APPEARS ON THE LIST OF THOSE EMPLOYEES ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN THIS ELECTION.

SECRET BALLOT VOTE: This election will be conducted under the supervision of the Regional Director of the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB). PERB will mail a ballot to the home address of each eligible voter on the date shown below. Along with the ballot, the eligible voter will also receive a secret ballot envelope, a postage-paid return envelope addressed to PERB and instructions for casting the ballot.


A sample of the official ballot is shown below. A majority of the valid ballots cast will determine the result of the election.

MAILED BALLOT ELECTION DATES:

- Friday October 14, 2005 - The Public Employment Relations Board will mail a ballot to the home address of each eligible voter.
- Friday November 18, 2005 5:00 p.m. - Voted ballots must be received by the Public Employment Relations Board by this date and time in order to be counted.
